### ★ Required Reading:

This will become part of the quarter 1 reading grade. Upon returning to school, students will be asked to create a short presentation to share with their classmates. This presentation will provide an opportunity for students to delve deeper into the themes, characters, and plot of the book. Please do not have students begin work on their presentation until the start of the new school year.
